

## NOTICE – JOURNEYMAN ELECTRICIANS

To insure journeymen stay abreast of the code changes all journeymen shall be required to show successful completion of ten hours of Board approved continuing education courses within twelve (12) months after the City of Toledo adopts the updated National Electrical Code. If the applicant fails to submit the required continuing education during the renewal period, he/she must reapply for the initial exam.

Code updates typically occur every three years. All journeymen will be required to present documentation of 10 hours of approved courses when they apply to renew for the 2009 City of Toledo Journeyman Electrician registration.
